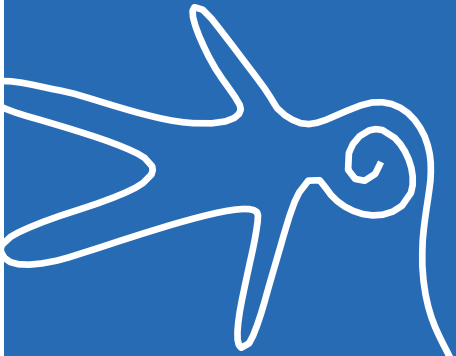


Getting to know each other

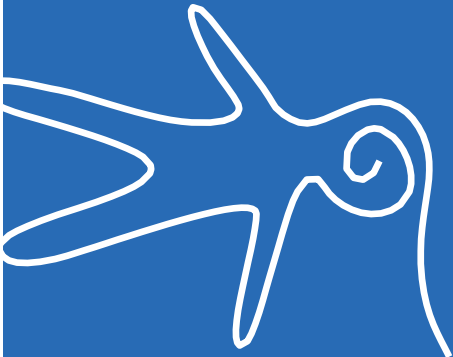
round 1

I commit to an open, honest and respectful dialogue.

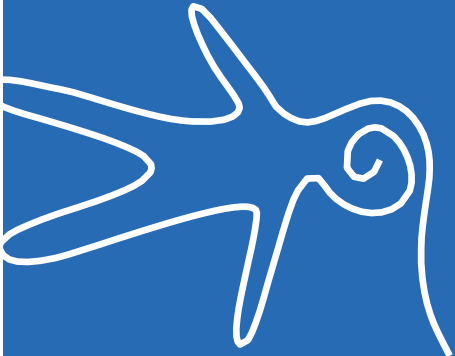
I pledge to truly see you and hear you.

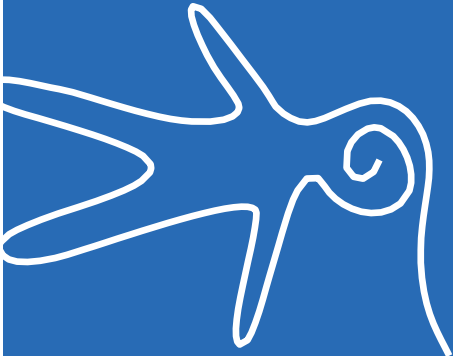

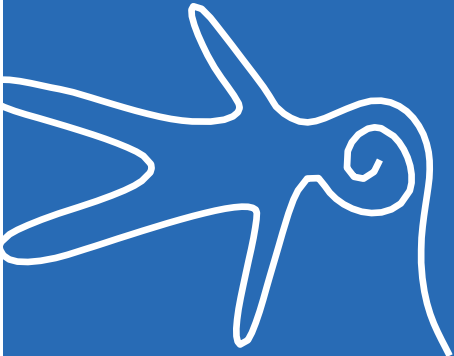

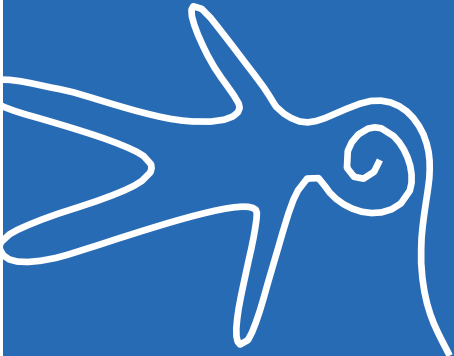
Goals

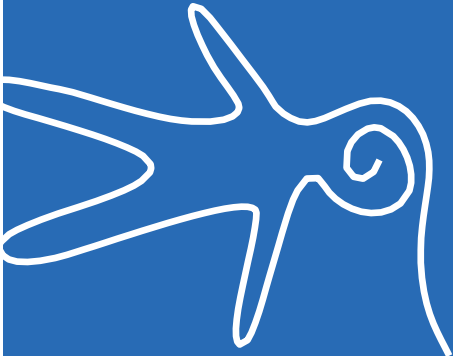


Random

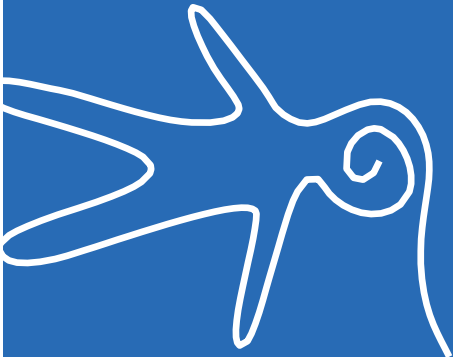


Priorities

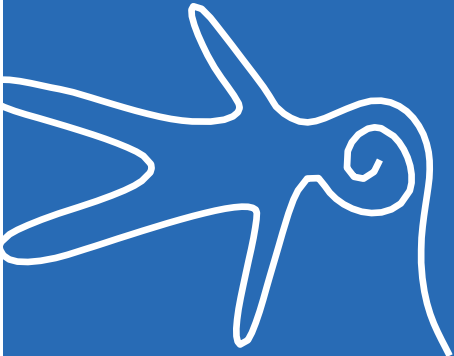


Relationships

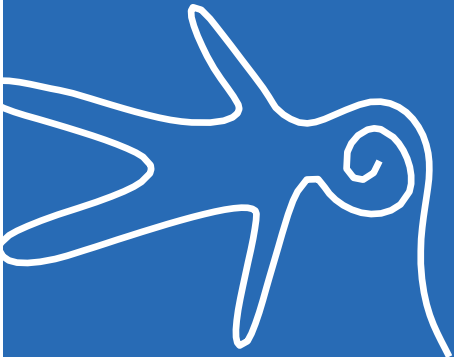
Gender

Getting to know each other



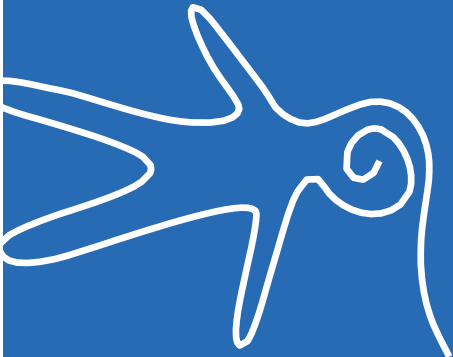
Relationships

Getting to know each other



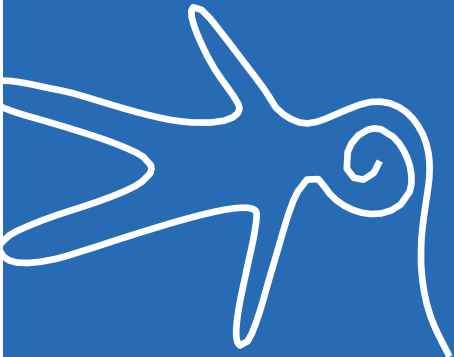
Sex & Pregnancy

Getting to know each other



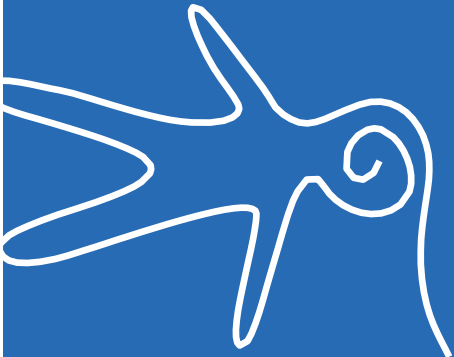
Consent

Getting to know each other



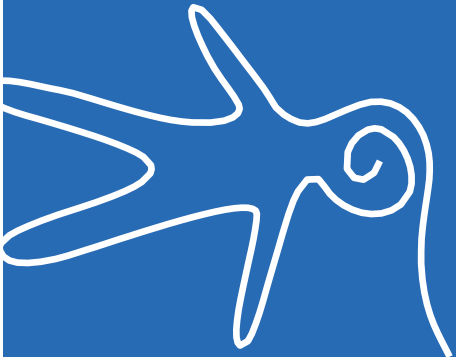
Religion
